Stage 4 — Up & Down

RULES: USPSA Rule Book, Current Edition

COURSE DESIGNER: Dan Wiswell

START POSITION: Seated on stool, facing down range with hands on knees, handgun is loaded and holstered.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, engage targets with 2 rounds each as they become visible and knock down steel from within the fault lines.

SCORING

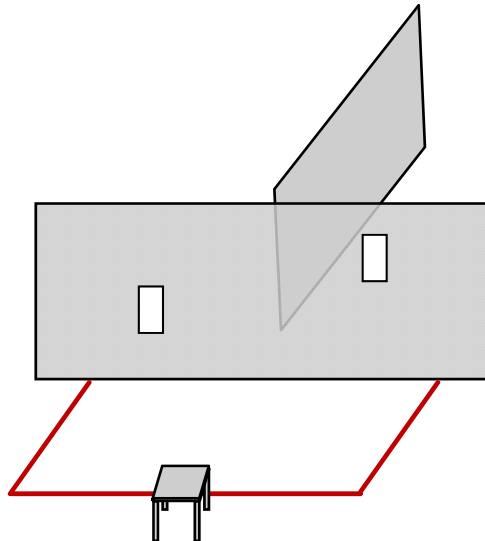
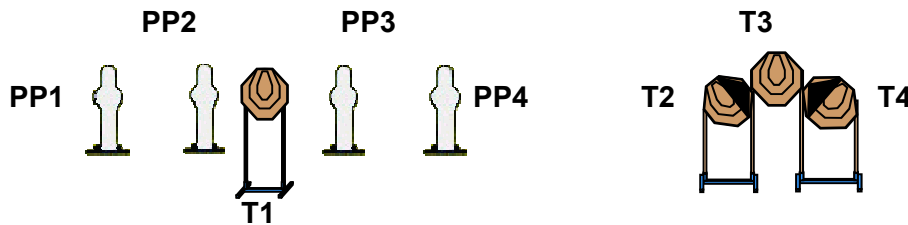
SCORING: Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points

TARGETS: 4 Classic, 4 PP

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per target, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Rule Book.



SETUP NOTES:

The wall with the ports is 12' wide and 6' high. The both ports are 3' from each end of the wall. Ports are 6" wide by 24" high. The low port is 12" from the ground to the bottom of the port, and the high port is 42" from the ground to the bottom of the port. T1 is 3' to the top, T3 is 54" to the top with T2 & T4 touching the bottom of T3.

RO NOTES:

It does not matter where the shooter's feet are in the start position.
